*****VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS*****

ALL HORSES AND PONIES MUST HAVE BEEN VACCINATED WITHIN THE LAST 12 MONTHS OR HAD THEIR FIRST 2 VACCINES OR BOOSTER 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE SHOW.

RING 1		
START TBC INDOORS ON SURFACE, COURSES WILL INCLUDE FILLERS FROM 70cm. CLASS SIZE LIMIT: 12 JACKETS AND TIES OPTIONAL.		
CLASS 1	CLEAR ROUND - TROT POLES	Open to all. Assistance allowed.
CLASS 2	35CM CROSS POLES	One round, timed. To be split juniors/seniors. Assistance allowed.
CLASS 3	40CM ALL ROUNDER	Think Working Hunter with a twist! Competitors to jump a course of 40cm jumps, immediately followed by a short show on both reins. All competitors will be invited back in for final judging, which won't include stripping the horse.
CLASS 4	50CM CLEAR ROUND	Open to all.
CLASS 5	50CM SINGLE PHASE	Riders to complete first part of the course untimed and continue straight onto timed section.
CLASS 6	60CM STYLE JUMPING	One round, not timed, judged on jumping style.
CLASS 7	70CM ALL ROUNDER	Think Working Hunter with a twist! Competitors to jump a course of 70cm jumps, immediately followed by a short show on both reins. All competitors will be invited back in for final judging, which won't include stripping the horse.
CLASS 8	70CM SINGLE PHASE	Riders to complete first part of the course untimed and continue straight onto timed section.
CLASS 9	70CM ACCUMULATOR	Each fence to carry a value. Highest score in 50 seconds. Joker fence of 85cm allowed to be jumped once to double score if cleared.
CLASS 10	CHASE ME CHARLIE	Starting at 70cm.
CLASS 11	80CM CLEAR ROUND	Open to all.
CLASS 12	80CM STYLE JUMPING	One round, not timed, judged on jumping style.
RING 2		
START TBC OUTDOOR – GRASS. CLASS SIZE LIMIT: 10		
RIDDEN CLASSES These classes are aimed at encouraging new combinations/nervous/returning riders etc. Competitors are asked to enter in the spirit of these classes and enter accordingly. There will be NO cantering as a ride and canter in the individual show is optional.		
RIDDEN JUDGE: LUCY GOODERHAM		
CLASS 13	RIDDEN PONY	Open to ponies 4 years old and over, 14.2hh and under. Riders any age, lead rein entries welcome.
CLASS 14	RIDDEN HORSE	Open to horses 4 years old and over, 14.3hh and over. Riders any age, lead rein entries welcome.
CLASS 15	RIDDEN COLOURED	Open to skewbalds, piebalds, palominos, spotted & duns aged 4 years and older. Rider any age, assistance allowed.
CLASS 16	RIDDEN COB	Open to traditional or hogged horses/ponies. 4 years old and over, any height. Rider any age, assistance allowed.

CLASS 17	RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY	Open to horses/ponies 4 years old and over. Riders any age. Will include 1 jump plus dismount on the wrong side and re-mounting on the correct side. Judged on horse's suitability as a riding club horse.
CLASS 18	LEAD REIN	Riders 12 years and under.
CLASS 19	JUST OFF LEAD REIN	Riders 12 years and under. Walk and trot only, assistance allowed if needed.
RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP		Open to 1 st and 2 nd placed in classes 13 to 19.
IN-HAND JUDGE: TBC		
CLASS 20	YOUNG HANDLER	Handler 16 years and under, assistance allowed if required.
CLASS 21	IN HAND YOUNGSTOCK	Open to 1,2 & 3 years old. Any type/breed.
CLASS 22	IN HAND M&M	Any age. May split between small and large breeds.
CLASS 23	IN HAND HUNTER/ RIDING HORSE	Any age. Any height.
CLASS 24	IN HAND COLOURED	Any age. Open to skewbalds, piebalds, palominos, spotted and duns.
CLASS 25	IN HAND COB	Any age, any height. Open to traditional/vanner/hogged cobs.
CLASS 26	IN HAND VETERAN	Open to horses/ponies 15 years and over. Any height. Special rosette to eldest equine.
CLASS 27	IN HAND NOVICE HORSE/PONY	Any age, any height. Combinations not to have achieved 2 x 1 st placings at any show.
IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP		Open to 1 st and 2 nd placed in classes 20 – 27.

OUTDOOR – GRASS		
FUN CLASSES can all be in-hand, lead rein or ridden.		
JUDGE: Hannah Rose		
CLASS 28	PRETTIEST MARE	Any age, any height.
CLASS 29	HANDSOMEST GELDING	Any age, any height.
CLASS 30	BEST DECORATED MANE AND TAIL	Any age, any height. Time will be allocated before the class to do the decorations.
CLASS 31	FANCY DRESS	Home-made if possible. Any age, any height. Time will be allocated before the class to get into costume.

Gymkhana classes will be split into ages as follows: lead rein; under 10 off lead rein; 11 – 17; 18 and over.		
CLASS 32	WALK AND TROT RACE	Competitors race up to the flag in walk and back in trot. If you break stride you must circle and then continue.
CLASS 33	FLAG RACE	Race to the first bollard and pull the flag out, race on to the second bollard and insert the flag then race back to the finish.
CLASS 34	BARREL RACE	Individually against the clock. Three barrels to race round in a cloverleaf pattern.

Gipping Riding Society Regulations

- The organizers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organizers and stewards.
- The judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the cause and be accompanied by a £20.00 deposit refundable only if the objection is upheld.
- The organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry or amend the schedule. The organizers will not tolerate disruptive behaviour from horses or riders.
- Gipping Riding Society shall not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident to any person, horse or property howsoever caused in connection with or arising out of this show. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the Gipping Riding Society or any person acting on their behalf against any legal action arising from such an incident.
- Properly secured protective headgear must be worn when mounted. Hats must be to one of the following standards: PAS015:1998 or 2011, VG 01.040: 2014-12 and also bear the BSI Kitemark or be Inspec IC marked; ASTM F1163:2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked; SNELL E2001 or SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838: 2006 Provided they are SAI Global marked.
- We recommend the use of back protectors.
- **Children aged 16 years and under must wear protective headgear to standard for all in-hand classes.**
- GRS recommends all competitors wear protective headgear to standard for in hand classes.
- All horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over to compete in ridden classes.
- Mountain and Moorland ponies entering other classes will be accepted unplaited.
- Do not obstruct the access - emergency services must have access to all parts of the event at all times.
- Small children must be accompanied at all times.
- **Competitors MUST hold adequate insurance cover including public liability insurance.**
- All horses and ponies must be vaccinated against Equine Influenza.
